With one out, **Maddox Corya** tapped a blooper over the second baseman allowing **Williams** to move to third base. **Davis Smith** walked to load the bases. **Parker Troughton** then earned a base and an RBI after working the full count into a walk. With **JC Slavis** at the plate, **Corya** scored on a wild pitch followed by two balls later, **Smith** scored on another wild pitch. **Slavis** then cranked a ball to center that crossed up the fielder earning him a double on the play and **Troughton** crossing the plate for an RBI. Twenty-five minutes later, the inning ended with Pope up 4-0.

Starting pitcher, **Israel** got in a little bit of a jam in the bottom of the first with runners on first and second and one out. He reached back and got a K swinging for the second out. A heads up play by **Jensen Morneau** from behind the plate to throw behind the runner leaning on first to **Thomas Williams** ended the inning. In the bottom of the third, **Israel** was in a bigger pickle with the bases loaded with 2 outs and the Knights threatening to put more runs on the board, he went to his tank, again, and threw three straight pitches to record a strikeout to end the inning.

With the game in free baseball mode in the eighth, **Ryan Healy** drew a 1 out four pitch walk. With two outs, Jack Healy beat out an infield hit for a single. **Thomas Williams** singled on a bunt to the third baseman to load them up. **Jensen Morneau** then stepped into the box. In what appeared to be a move by the pitcher to try to command the ball back to his hand after he threw it, plunked **Morneau** with a in the earhole with a 1-2 count at 67mph. **Ryan Healy** strolled home as Morneau took his base. The inning ended with an out on the basepaths but the Hounds were up 5-4.

Corya came out of the dugout charged up with the lead and set the batters down in 1-2-3 order to end the game. What a game.

With the win, the JV Greyhounds moved their record above .500 ending at 11-10 for the season. A fabulous showing... We can't wait to see what next year holds.
